Privacy Notice:

What information will we use:

We will collect and use information about you in the course of organising funerals and setting up funeral plans. This information may include your name, address, contact numbers and email address.

How will your information be used:

The personal data given to us will be used to enable us to professionally and effectively deal with yourself when you require our services.

Where we will store your data:

Only your name and your email address (if provided) will be stored electronically.

Paper documents are securely stored in locked cabinets.

Your Rights:

- Request us to delete personal information in certain circumstances
- Request to restrict use of your data
